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SDG1 report : No poverty

The UEMF is committed to the fight against poverty and involves its entire community in helping to solve this problem through various social actions.

Communication

This work begins by communicating with families and people from poor backgrounds in order to inform them of:

- Quality training and education offerings from UEMF.
- Stock exchanges and insurance
- Student living conditions

The communication activities are multiple and concern participation in:

- -student fairs in all regions of the country and in particular the most disadvantaged
- -mobile caravans co-organized with NGOs in rural and difficult to access areas

To this end, the UEMF has signed several agreements with NGOs and foundations to provide them with merit scholarships for the benefit of candidates from disadvantaged backgrounds. These scholarships are in the form of free or partially free educational places throughout the duration of the studies.

UEMF scholarships

- Our University was created as a non-profit association under the name of Foundation and enjoying public utility. It does not have shareholders, but contributors and donors.
- Our mission is public and our management method is private, without the aim of profit.
- Our objective is above all to offer higher education and research programs of excellence that meet the best international standards.
- Our desire is to make the Euromed University of Fez accessible to a greater number of students, by setting up several categories of scholarships:
 - 1. Excellence scholarships for brilliant students who have distinguished themselves by the excellence of their academic record, regardless of family income:
 - 2. Merit scholarships for students from low-income backgrounds with a very good academic record;
 - 3. Solidarity scholarships covering tuition, residence and catering costs for good students from disadvantaged backgrounds;
 - 4. "Africa" scholarships for good sub-Saharan students with modest incomes;
 - 5. Total exemption from tuition fees for all doctoral students;
 - 6. Attractive and competitive subsistence scholarships for doctoral students 5000Dh net/month minimum;
 - 7. Attractive and competitive scholarships for postdoctoral researchers between 13,000 and 25,000 Dh net/month
 - All scholarships are examined by a commission which acts in a rigorous, transparent and equitable manner and no other consideration can interfere with the sine qua non criteria of excellence.





• For the 2022/2023 school year, several scholarships have been awarded to students, to partially or fully cover tuition, residence and catering costs for the various programs offered.

Tuition scholarships

For each of the two categories (Excellence and Merit), there are four types of scholarship:

- 1. Scholarship to cover 100% of registration and tuition fees
- 2. Scholarship to cover 75% of registration and tuition fees
- 3. Scholarship to cover 50% of registration and tuition fees
- 4. Scholarship to cover 25% of registration and tuition fees

Total number of students: 3,000 in 2022-2023, more than half of whom are on scholarships.

Solidarity scholarships

The UEMF grants solidarity scholarships to cover up to 100% of residence and catering costs, for students with a good academic record and from disadvantaged backgrounds.

The UEMF is strongly involved in its local, regional and national environment and works for solidarity by:

- 1. Providing access to educational resources for those not studying at university for example, computers, bibliographic works, online courses and access to lectures;
- 2. Organizing events at the university open to the general public: public lectures, community educational events;
- 3. Traveling to local and regional schools for awareness-raising activities, studentrun social and voluntary projects or to improve access to basic services(food, accommodation, transportation).

Donations obtained by the UEMF for the benefit of scholarship students

A donation of 5 million euros from the EU through the Competitiveness and Green Growth Support Program (PACC) aimed at supporting the University's scholarship policy for equitable access for deserving students to a higher education offering of excellence and also the promotion of training courses in green professions

Loan possibilities

Students registered at UEMF have the possibility of taking out a study loan with an exceptional interest rate of 2% and not repaying it until the sixth year, i.e. one year after obtaining their diploma. Master's degree or equivalent to Bac+5.

Scholarships for students from low-income countries

The UEMF gives particular importance to the training of students from low-income friendly countries. To this end, the university has the services of an advisor to the president to:

 Develop and identify partnership opportunities for the UEMF with public and private establishments, particularly across the African continent.





- Develop and strengthen cultural, scientific and economic relations with partner countries, particularly within the framework of South-South cooperation;
- Represent the University in professional events such as trade fairs and international events.
- Monitor the implementation of support measures (sources of funding, accommodation, internships, etc.) taken by the UEMF to facilitate and improve the reception and recruitment of students from low-income countries.

Several conventions are operational to provide scholarships to African students including those signed with:

Mobility scholarships abroad

For our students who wish to complete part of their studies abroad, the cost of their international mobility can be partially covered by scholarship programs, depending on the destinations and types of mobility, such as:

- The ERASMUS program and in particular K107 which has enabled dozens of mobility for INSA EM engineering students;
- Double degree agreements (example Master of Business Law with the Sorbonne Law School);
- EMADU agreements with the Architecture departments of the universities of Mons (Belgium) and Florence (Italy).

Health and Hygiene

- The provision of medical and paramedical care: availability of an infirmary and paramedical staff;
- Monitoring the state of hygiene of university premises;
- Health education;
- Organization of health awareness and information campaigns;
- Monitoring the state of food hygiene and the hygiene and safety of the university environment.





Local start-up help

Provide assistance to the local community by supporting sustainable business start-ups through education or relevant resources (mentoring programs, training workshops, open access to university facilities). 

Actions during Covid 19

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, the EU made an additional donation of 5.4 million dirhams to the EuroMed University of Fez(UEMF), intended for the acquisition of computer and laboratory equipment. This support allowed the University to ensure educational continuity for its scholarship students and to manufacture medical protection equipment.

All united against Covid-19: educational continuity ensured by the Euromed University of Fez with the support of the European Union (eib.org).

A donation of 500,000 euros from the European Union for the acquisition of IT equipment (computers, Internet connection keys and subscriptions) and laboratory equipment (3D printers). This equipment allowed the university on the one hand to ensure educational continuity for 420 of its scholarship students who were isolated or not equipped with a computer, and on the other hand to manufacture medical protection equipment to fight against the coronavirus pandemic. Offers laptops to scholarship holders

ReadEuromed University of Fez, with the financial support of the European Union, offered all its scholarship recipients magnificent new PCs (HP core i5 8th Gen) accompanied by 4G keys and a one-year internet subscription. A total of 420 kits were distributed, including 26 to Sanady scholarship recipients. This great initiative will allow scholarship students to overcome the difficulties linked to the lack of equipment during this period of confinement and to continue this school year in the best way.

2024: Euromed University of Fez at the heart of action for the SDGs

Launch of the first Bootcamp of the Tech4Farmers program at the Euromed University of Fez



From June 10 to 12, a bootcamp brought together AgriTech innovators supported by the French Development Agency (AFD) as part of the "Tamkin LiTanmia" project, in partnership with the Regional AgriTech Innovation and Entrepreneurship Hub of Fez-Meknes. Participants included promising start-ups such as DeepLeaf, Jafife, ARWA Solutions, and Agrl-bOT, each bringing their expertise to transform agriculture sustainably.

The first day was dedicated to welcoming, introductions to Design Thinking and discussions with experts. The second day explored project development and prototyping, including role-plays to understand user needs and funding opportunities. Finally, the third day focused on partnerships, with feedback and individual coaching sessions. This program offered start-ups a platform to innovate, strengthen synergies and contribute to the sustainable development of the region.

UEMF students make the voices of young Africans and Euro-Mediterraneans heard before the Parliamentary Assembly of the Union for the Mediterranean



Students from the Euromed University of Fez organized a summit on February 14, 2024 under the theme "Euro-Mediterranean and Transatlantic Opening" with more than 200 participants from 30 countries. This summit addressed topics such as energy ethics, sustainable development, transport, climate change, and the challenges of Africa.

The summit culminated in the Call for Investment in the Future, read out on 16 February at the 8th Summit of Speakers of Parliaments of the Union for the Mediterranean. The call highlights the need to strengthen cooperation between Europe and Africa through concrete projects, to allocate the funds promised for climate resilience, and to support initiatives such as the Nigeria-Morocco gas pipeline.

The students also welcomed Morocco's initiatives for economic integration, infrastructure and education in Africa, while calling for a "Marshall Plan" for education and research in Africa, as an investment in the future to combat poverty, terrorism and illegal immigration.
